### WHO CAN ATTEND

Registration is open to all families. This will be an intergenerational week for infants to grandparents. Rules for acceptance and participation in the servant event program are the same for everyone without regard to race, color, national origin, sex, or handicap.

### PROGRAM FOR THE WEEK

The program will be geared to all ages and will include daily time to worship, work, play, and relax. Servants will participate together on various work projects on the camp grounds. Carpentry, painting, gardening, and sewing will be just some of the skills put to use during our week together. It is an intergenerational event! It is a time of working together and learning about each other and our Lord through servanthood.

### ACCOMMODATIONS

Families have the option of staying in Woodland Cottages, Founders Court, Family Court or Schroeter Circle. Cabins will be available on a first come - first serve registration basis.

***Founders Court:*** Each cabin has a full bathroom including shower, two twin beds, and a connecting door to the next cabin. A family of four can be accommodated comfortably in two connecting cabins.

***Refurbished Founders Court:*** Each cabin sleeps up to four people. Each cabin is carpeted and features a queen size bed, a futon that converts to a double bed or a set of bunk beds, table, chairs, and a private bathroom with shower. ***Add an additional \$100 for the week.***

**Family Court:** Each cabin has a full bathroom including shower and two twin bunk beds. A family of four (or five with a crib) can be accommodated comfortably.

**Refurbished Family Court:** Each cabin sleeps six people, which is wonderful for larger families. A bunkroom sleeps four and a second room sleeps two in a double bed. Other amenities include a dresser, a nightstand, table and chairs, closet, and a private bathroom and shower. **Add an additional \$100 for the week.**

**Schroeter Circle:** These are year-round winterized cabins. Each cabin has six bedrooms, and can accommodate 20 people. Four bedrooms have two twin bunk beds, and two bedrooms have one bunk bed. Each cabin has two full bathrooms including showers. A common room with tables and chairs is the front room in the cabin, and has an optional divider.

**Woodland Cottages:** Our newest cabins, these year-round bungalows can house up to 6-8 people with a queen bed, bunkroom that sleeps four, and a pull-out sofa in the living room. These cottages also have a full bathroom with large tub and shower and a full kitchen with stove, oven, microwave, refrigerator, coffee maker, and all dishes and cookware. All cottages have heat and air conditioning as well as a wonderful porch to relax on.

- If a crib is needed we have a few available, or suggest you bring a port-a-crib.
- Linens, pillows, and blankets are provided. Please bring towels.
- Laundry facilities are available on-site.

## **REGISTRATION DEADLINE**

Upon receipt of the deposit and the registration form, you will receive a letter of confirmation, a listing of items to bring, an emergency/medical information form, and an authorized Consent and Liability Waiver Form. These forms must be received to complete registration.

## **CANCELLATION POLICY**

Total camp fee will be forfeited unless cancellation is received 60 days prior to your scheduled arrival, in which case all funds, except the non-refundable deposit, will be returned. If Pioneer must cancel for any reason, a full refund will be given.
