

Papyrus Camp

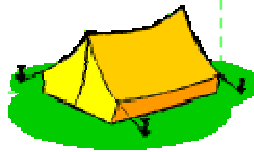

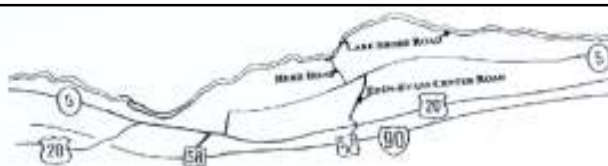

Pioneer Camp and Retreat Center is located 30 miles south of Buffalo, New York, and one hour from Niagara Falls, New York, and Canada.

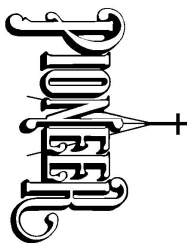
- If you are coming from I-90 West, take exit 57A
