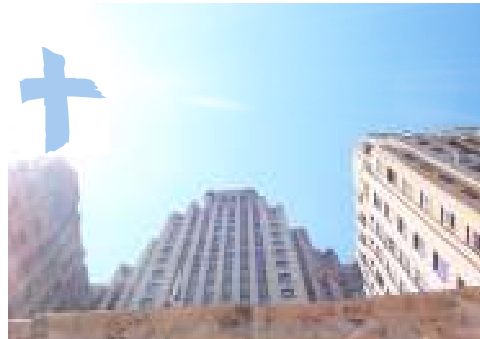

WHO CAN ATTEND:

Registration is open to all those 13-22 years of age. College individuals and adults can serve as chaperones. Rules for acceptance and participation in the servant event are the same for everyone without regard to race, color, national origin, sex, or handicap.

WHAT'S INCLUDED IN THE PRICE PER PERSON:

*Meals from Sunday dinner to Friday lunch

*Lodging at Pioneer Camp, in our Schroeter Circle cabins. Each cabin accommodates up to 20 people. Amenities: bunkbeds, bathrooms with showers, and a small gathering area. If attendance is high there may be a need to house groups in our large meeting halls, sleeping on the floor. Housing is separated by male and female; participants may be housed with servants from other youth groups.

TO REGISTER:

To register your group, please contact our office for registration forms.

REGISTRATION DEADLINE:

Registrations are accepted on a first come—first serve basis. To assure that your group has an opportunity to be a part of the event, please reply as soon as possible. We will take registrations until we are full. If the event has reached maximum capacity, your full deposit will be refunded.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION:

Upon receipt of the registration form and deposit, the registrant will receive a letter of confirmation, a list of items to bring, an emergency/medical information form, an over the counter medication form, and a consent and liability waiver. These forms must be received to complete registration.

CANCELLATION POLICY:

Total camp fees will be forfeited unless cancellation is received 90 days prior to your scheduled arrival, in which case all funds except the \$75.00 non-refundable deposit per person, will be returned. If Pioneer must cancel for any reason, a full refund will be given.

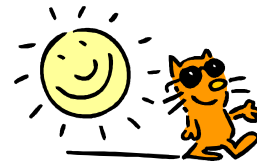
